Similarly, no one puts new wine into old wineskins; otherwise, the wine will burst the skins, and the wine is lost, and so are the skins, but one puts new wine into fresh wineskins." - Mark 2:21-22

Highlights:

- John M. Olson, Financial Adviser (with Janney Montgomery Scott LLC), met briefly with Consistory. Mr. Olson has previously assisted non-profit organizations with investments; and provided a handout titled Fiduciary roadmap for non-profit organizations.
- Update on sale of rental properties as result of the Special Congregational Meeting held on Sunday, November 13, 2022. The sale of the 903 Washington Avenue rental property will be proceeding. The sale of the 912 Lincoln Avenue rental property will not be proceeding at this moment in time since this rental is not ready for immediate sale.
