SOME THOUGHTS ON THE SEASON

from Pastor Bob Gutekunst

I remember taking a class at Moravian Seminary. The professor was comparing two individuals who had been raised from the dead, Lazarus and Jesus. Whereas Lazarus had been raised back to the same, old life he knew before, the professor said, the Resurrection of Jesus was about living a completely new and different life. Jesus was transformed. Jesus' life was changed.

It seems fitting then that we, the members of Grace United Church of Christ and me, as your new pastor, are beginning this new chapter in our faith story together during this Easter season, a season of change. 
